Eligibility: Open to any individual.

Entries: All entries will be conducted on match day during registration. Advance entries; please contact Brian Keene (brian@king40.com). MCGC website - www.magiccitygunclub.com

Checks should be made payable to **Magic City Gun Club**.

Rules: Current CMP Pistol Competition Rules will apply for all matches. CMP affidavits will be processed during check in.

Awards: Awards will be issued to the top three overall, as well as the high scorer in each classification. Trophies and plaques, along with cash prizes. Random cash drawings will also be held so all might have a chance to win.

Classification: The CMP classification system will be used in the 2700. Individuals who have not been classified with the CMP but who have an NRA classification will use their NRA Classification. Those who have neither will fire in the Master or Unclassified Class.

Divisions: The CMP equipment division system will be used for the championship. Those divisions are: Open, Metallic and 22 only. Scores will be reported as noted on competitor's score cards. A minimum of five competitors must participate to offer a separate championship for either division other than OPEN.

Categories: There will be Civilian and Military categories for this Championship. NOTE: Police and Military competitors will compete in Civilian category for awards. Scores will be reported as Police/Military category on CMP scorecards.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$2 will be charged for each challenge made. See the CMP rulebook for correct procedure.

Refunds: If a competitor cannot complete a portion of the matches previously paid for, refunds will be apportioned for payment received. If a competitor purchased the “Full Package”, refunds will be given at a rate of up to \$10 per each of the CMP EIC Matches not fired for any reason (including a lack of minimum participants), and \$25 per 900.

Time of Firing: Firing will commence at 9:00 AM each day. Lunch on Saturday provided by Magic City Gun Club. Water and snacks provided by Magic City Gun Club.

Entries: All entries will be conducted on match day during registration and squadding. Reservations can be made via email: brian@king40.com

Entries Close: All individual match entries will be processed before the first match.

Entries Limited: Entries are limited to 30 competitors. Preference will be given to competitors who have made a reservation through email. **No additional relays will be added.**

The CMP Service Pistol, CMP 22 Rimfire EIC, and CMP EIC Revolver Matches will be conducted immediately following the lunch break on Saturday. The awards ceremony will be held immediately following completion of the match on Sunday.

Directions to Range: From I-65, take exit 280 to Highway 31 South, left on Morris Majestic Road/151/131, cross New Castle/Bradford Road, and Morris Majestic becomes Narrows Road. Range is 1.7 miles on left.

From I-59, take exit 141 onto Chalkville Road, cross Old Springville Road, turns to Sweeny Hollow Road, take to Pinson Valley Road/ Highway 79, turn right onto Hwy 79. Go approx. 2 miles and take left onto Narrows Road at traffic light. Range is 2.3 miles on right.

From I-20: Take exit 136 to I-459 North. Use exit 33-B to get on I-59 N. Take exit 141 onto Chalkville Mt. Road (turn left), continue on Chalkville Mt. Road which crosses Old Springville Road, turns to Sweeny Hollow Road, take to Pinson Valley Road/ Highway 79, turn right onto Hwy 79. Go approx. 2 miles and take left onto Narrows Road at traffic light. Range is 2.3 miles on right.

Lodging: All expenses and reservations for lodging, travel to and from this competition, local transportation, etc. are the responsibility of the competitor. Numerous motels and hotels in the Birmingham area are available and are located at the intersections of I-459, I-20/59 and I-65. The closest would be Gardendale/Fultondale area. Next would be the Trussville area.
